

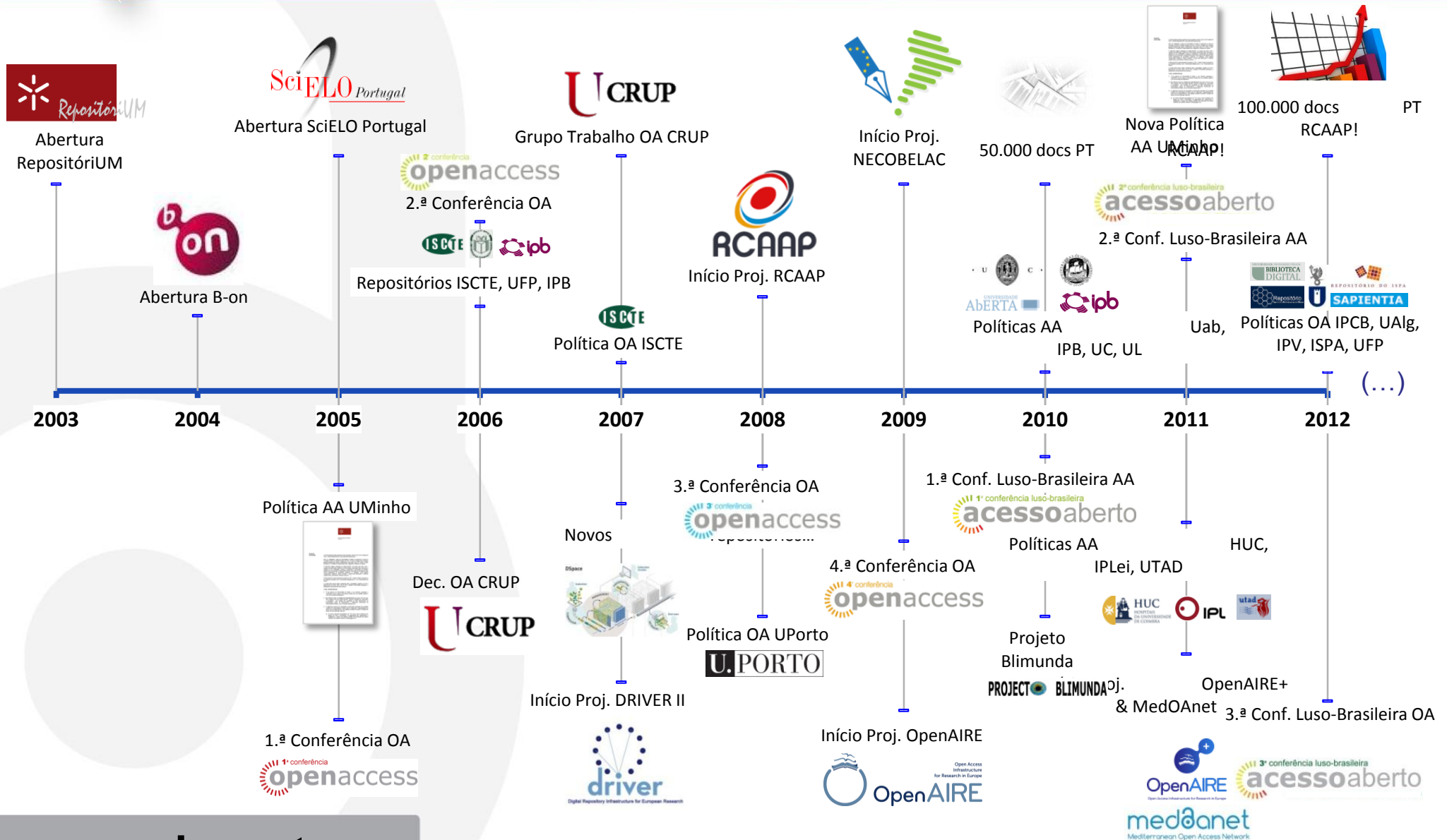

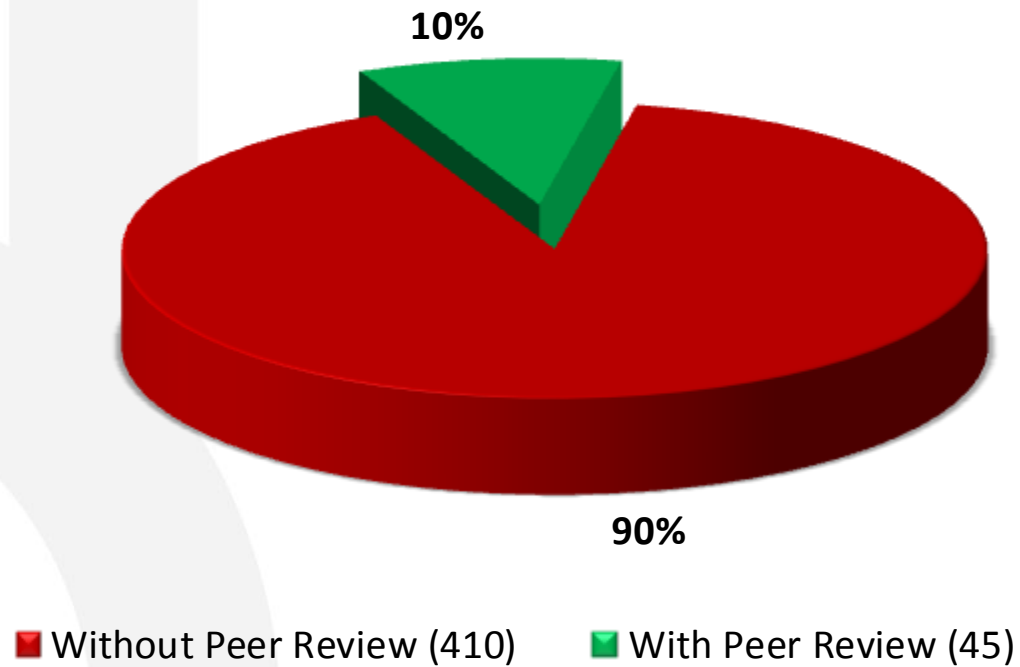

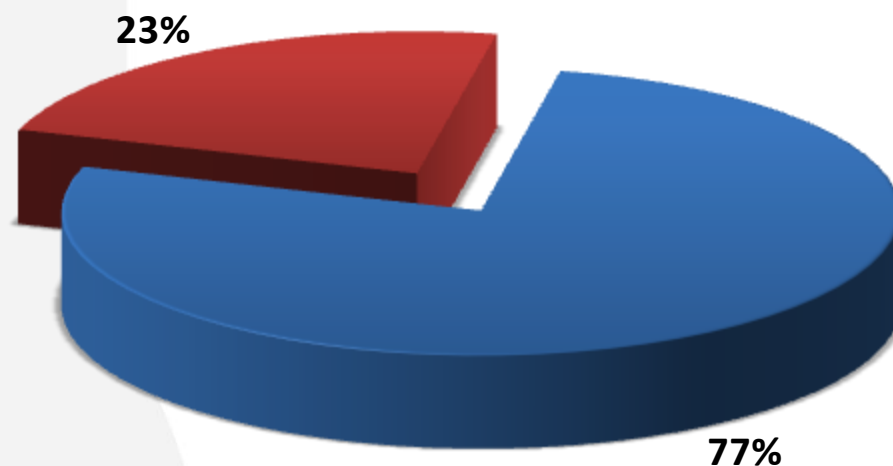


Number of active scientific journals in Portugal Including electronic versions and possibly co-published with other(s) country or countries

SciELO Portugal gathers 41 open access journals from Portuguese institutions



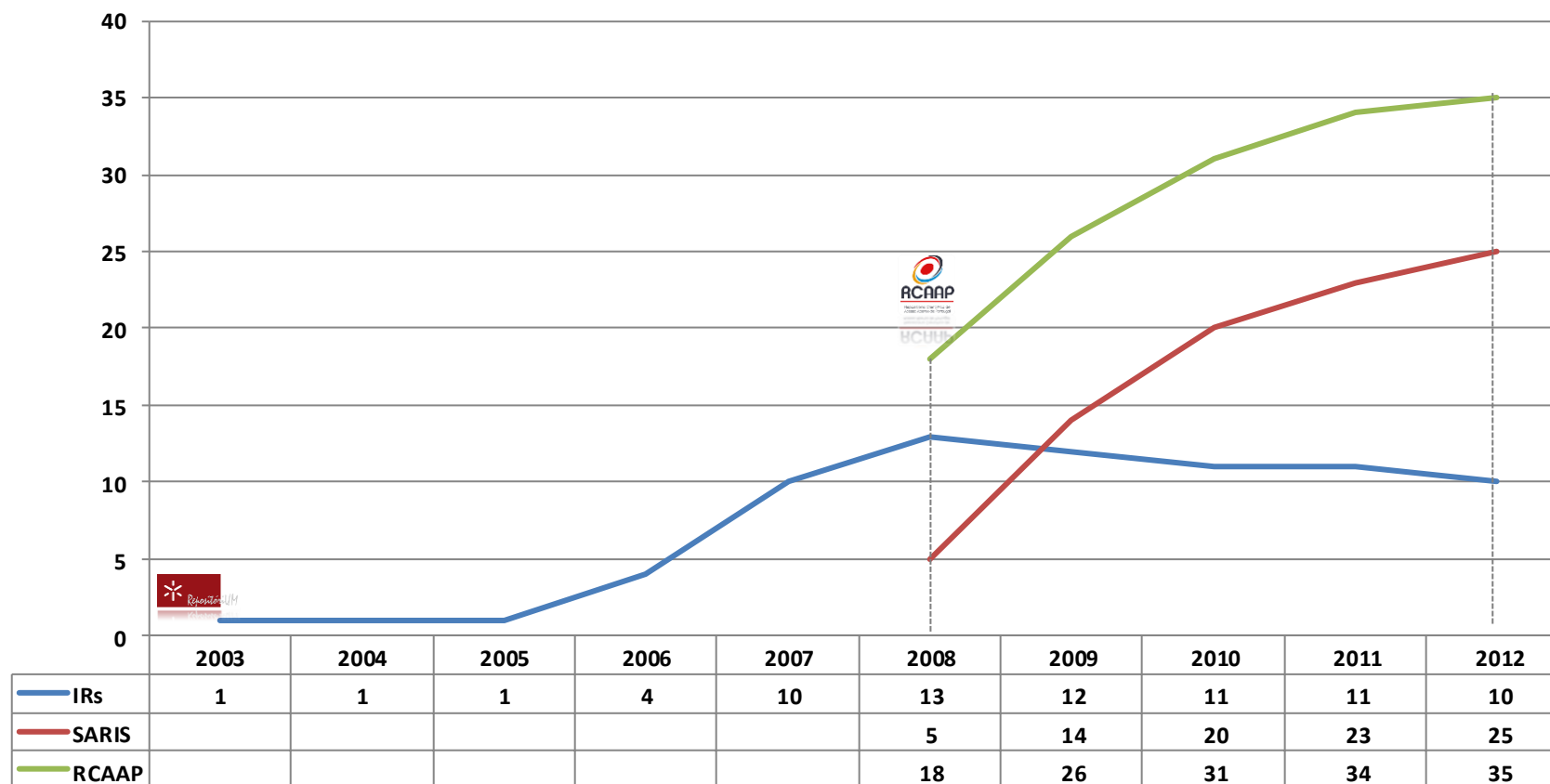

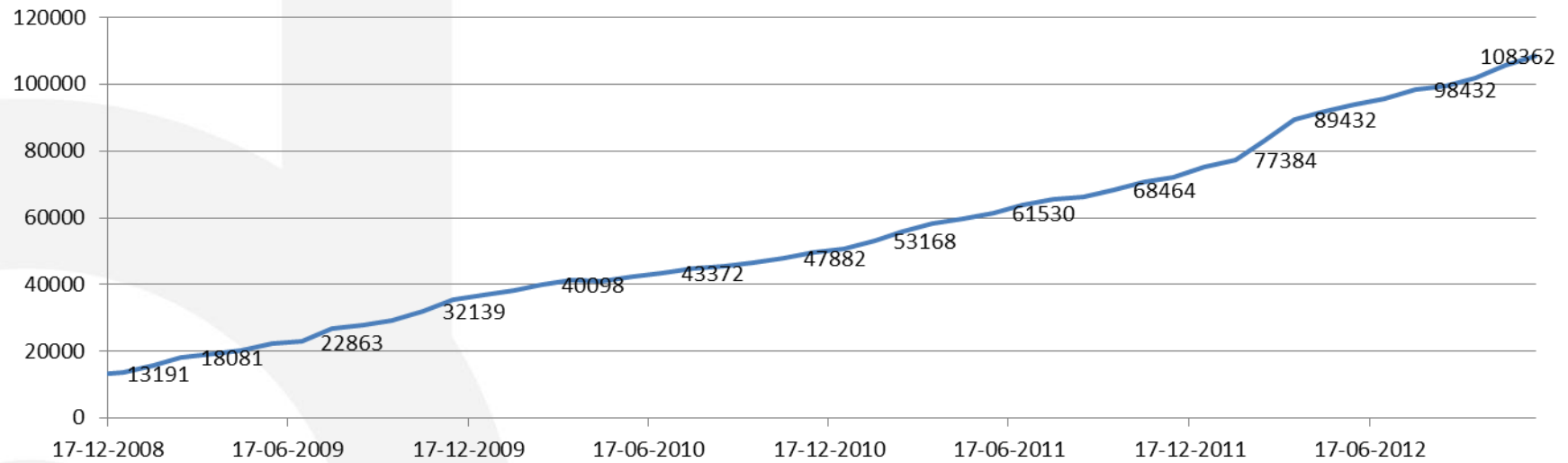

- Portugal has only one public funder (FCT) which announced an OA Policy in October 2012. At the moment, not launched yet!
- One private funder completed the MedOAnet survey. Most Portuguese private funders are foundations
- The private funder reported to be aware that the EC proposed that 100% of research outputs in Horizon 2020 should be available in OA
